LRAC Otter Tail County and Alternate Becker County Board Members Appointed

Nominations for Jon Solinger and Stacy Lundquist were approved at the LRAC May 16 Board meeting.



Jon Solilnger, Pelican Rapids, will serve as a Becker Co. Board member, living in an adjoining county for a 1 year term, renewable annually, effective July 1, 2017.

Asked why he was interested in serving as a Board member Jon said, "I would like to contribute to the work of offering the arts to all people our region, making art a meaningful and expected part of our lives, not a luxury or something intended for another population. I want to help in bringing quality art to the region and to nurturing artists in our own neighborhood who tell our stories and express who we are through their work."

Stacy Lundquist, Battle Lake, will serve as an Otter Tail County Board member for a three year term, effective July 1, 2017.



FY2018 Folk and Traditional Arts Program

Folk and traditional arts refer to artistic traditions that come from and are rooted in the cultural life of a community. Community members may share a common ethnicity, geographic location, occupation, language, or tribal affiliation. Folk and traditional arts are learned and passed on through community based systems of training and education where younger generations learn and attain mastery of a form by observation and practice or through apprenticeships with elders and masters.

• Deadline is Friday, June 2, 2017



FY2018 Community Arts Education Support

The Community Arts Education Support grant program provides operating support to build and strengthen the capacity of exceptional arts education organizations, or of arts education programs of public or nonprofit organizations that have a sustained commitment to providing ongoing, rigorous arts education opportunities in community settings.

• Deadline is Friday, July 14, 2017

FY2018 Arts Tour Minnesota

Arts Tour Minnesota is a program designed to provide Minnesotans greater access to high quality arts activities regardless of geographic location. Grants may be used to support Minnesota presenters hosting professional tours by Minnesota and nonMinnesota artists, or to support Minnesota artists and arts organizations touring existing artworks to Minnesota communities that are outside of their home region. The program is open to tours featuring visual, literary, and performing arts.

• Deadline is Friday, July 21, 2017
