



Featured Artist

Heather Slomski: Writer, Instructor of Literature & Arts Mentorship Program Mentor

Heather A. Slomski has been a Minnesota resident since 2010 when she moved to Moorhead with her husband. In 2013 she was a recipient of an Emerging Writers' Grant funded by The Loft Literary Center and the Jerome Foundation, and also of a Minnesota State Arts Board Grant. In 2014 she published her story collection, *The Lovers Set Down Their Spoons*, which won the Iowa Short Fiction Award and was a finalist for the Minnesota Book Award. Since publishing her story collection, Heather has been working on longer works—two novel manuscripts which are nearing completion.



Among other schools, Heather has taught writing classes at The Loft Literary Center and Concordia College. She has also edited manuscripts for Milkweed Editions and Sarabande Books. When working with students and other writers, she helps them to look closely at their language in order to cut back overwritten passages, to replace tired phrasings with original diction, to make dialogue seem effortless and natural while conveying subtle subtext, her philosophy being that carefully worked surfaces allow a text's deeper meanings to come through on their own. She is a proponent of precision, brevity, and of finding the line between a writer's job and a reader's and taking care to never cross it.
