Michael Weatherly: Printmaker & Arts Mentorship Program Mentor

Michael Weatherly is a Minnesota based contemporary printmaker who was born in 1966 in the small southwestern Minnesota town of Holland. He further his education at the University of Minnesota Morris obtaining a BA in Art history and minor in Studio art with an emphasis in printmaking. While at UMM he also studied painting under John Stuart Ingle.

During college Michael discovered the printing process of mono-printing and currently incorporates this printmaking technique with manipulated digital images. His art is characterized by vibrant colors, material elements and stark black lines.



Weatherly currently lives in Elbow Lake, MN. He has been the recipient of several artist grants including the McKnight Foundation Artist Grant, the Minnesota Arts and Cultural Heritage Grant and Individual Artist Grants from the Lake Regions Arts Council. He has exhibited his work both locally and nationally and had recent solo exhibitions in Minnesota and has participated in group shows including Altered Esthetics (Minneapolis, MN), the University of Minnesota Morris (Morris, MN), Lake Regions Arts Council Gallery (Fergus Falls, MN), Minneapolis Institute for the Arts (Minneapolis, MN), and The Giles Gallery (Richmond, KY).


Eight, \$1,000 grants to be awarded

LRAC Fall Project Grant

<u>Up to \$3,000 for eligible organizations</u>

20% match suspended this year

Eligible organizations in the LRAC nine-county region may apply for the LRAC Fall Project Grant. Project Grant activities must be directly involved in the creation, performance and/or exhibition of an artistic project. The Project Grant is open to all artistic disciplines.

Fall Project Grant Important Dates:

- Application available: July 18, 2022
- Grant Deadline: Thursday, September 1, 2022 at 5:00 pm
- Grant Review: Tuesday, October 18, 2022

The Minnesota State Arts Board (MSAB) is a state agency that stimulates and encourages the creation, performance, and appreciation of the arts in the state. For Individuals: Creative Support for Individuals

This grant program provides support to help individual artists and culture bearers sustain their creative practices and meaningfully engage with their communities in a time of transition. Creative



Support grants are designed to be flexible and allow for adaptable responses to unexpected changes during the grant period.

• Friday, July 15, 2022, before 4:30 p.m.



For Organizations: Creative Support for Organizations

This grant program provides support to help organizations deliver arts programming and meaningfully engage their communities in a time of transition. While Creative Support grants are designed to be flexible and allow for adaptable responses to unexpected changes during the grant period, applicants will be asked to align their activities with one of three program outcomes that address the intent of the legacy amendment and the Arts Board's goals.

Application deadline:

• Friday, September 9, 2022, before 4:30 p.m
